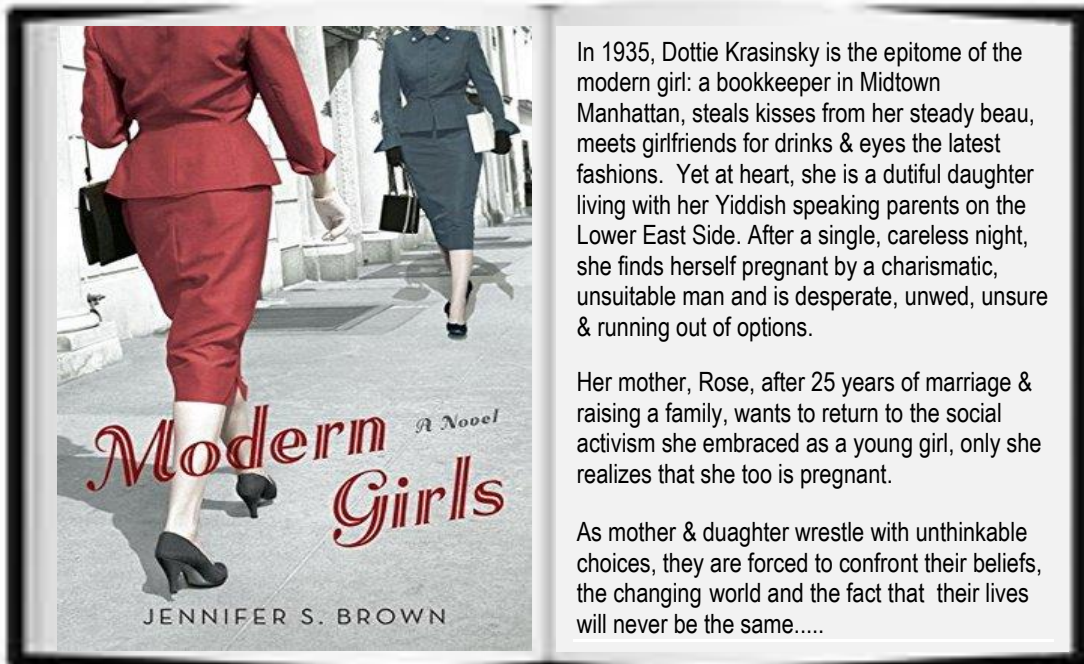




SISTERHOOD BOOK CLUB
