



SELLING THE CHAMETZ — During the holiday of Passover, Jews are forbidden to eat any chametz and are also prohibited from owning any chametz. Consequently arrangements are made prior to the start of Passover to legally transfer the title to all leavened goods in one's possession to a non-Jew who then assumes ownership of these products during Passover. It is this procedure of transferring ownership to which one refers when using the phrase "selling the chametz". Rabbi Pivo will gladly act as your agent and arrange for the sale of your chametz so that none of it is legally yours during the holiday. Please contact the Rabbi about this matter before April 6th or send in the form below so that it reaches the synagogue before that date.

Complete this form and return it to Rabbi Pivo by April 6th in order for your Chametz to be sold before Passover begins.
